JUDGING: Commences 9am Saturday 13th May 2017

- * All cattle to be registered with their respective Breed Societies, & to be tagged with NLIS and be supported by a NSW animal Health Statement, copy of registration certificate to be supplied.
- * **NLIS numbers to be provided together with NVD & Waybill document number*****
- * All cattle entries must be BVDV Free – (non-PI) Evidence must be provided with entry
- * **JOHNES DISEASE DECLARATION FORM** must be completed & returned with entries.
- * Any animals infected with warts or ringworm will be deemed ineligible for exhibition at show.
- * All cattle will be inspected by Veterinarian prior to judging
- * Ages of cattle to be calculated as of 1st May 2017
- * Cattle to be tied with suitable neck collars & halters.
- * All bulls over 12 months of age are to have nose rings.
- * All females must be led with nose clip.
- * All cattle to be on the ground by 8am Saturday 13th May 2017
- * Early entry after 3pm Friday 12th May 2017 is permitted.
- * Entry passes will be issued by return mail on receipt of entry and entry fee, on the following basis: 1-3 head = 1pass, 4 -6 head = 2 passes, over 6 head = 3 passes.
- * Exhibitors are strongly advised to ensure that they and their animals are covered by Public Liability Insurance.
- * All electrical appliances, eg. extension cords and blower's must have a certificate from a licensed electrician and certificates must be shown to stewards before they can be used.
